

THIS IS THE WILL of me DOROTHY ADA BIGGS of 18, Ladbroke Road, Bush Hill Park, Enfield in the County of Middlesex.

1. I REVOKE all former Wills and Testamentary documents at any time heretofore made by me.
2. I APPOINT Barclays Bank Limited (hereinafter called "the Bank") to be the Executor and Trustee of this my Will with power to act by its proper officer or officers and also to act as Bankers to my Estate for all purposes upon the terms usual between the Bank and a customer and the Bank shall also be entitled to remuneration for its service as such Executor and Trustee by fees and otherwise in accordance with the terms of remuneration charged by it at the date of my death for its services in acting as Executor and/or Trustee of a Will free from duties and deductions and to be paid or retained out of any part of the capital or income of my estate in priority to all other payments and also to any customer share of brokerage receivable by the Bank.

The Bank may in its absolute discretion determine how any fees or other remuneration payable to the Bank be borne as between different parts of my estate and as between persons beneficially interested in capital and income respectively of any part of my estate and every such determination shall be binding on all persons beneficially interested hereunder.

I approve of the appointment of Messrs. Weld & Deavan of 32, Little Park Gardens, Enfield, Middlesex as Solicitors in connection with my estate.

3. I BEQUEATH to my daughter June Marguerite Boddington of 22, Princess Margaret Boulevard, Toronto, Canada all jewellery real or artificial owned by me at the date of my death.
4. I BEQUEATH all stocks and shares of any nature whatsoever and whether Preference ordinary deferred or debenture to my great niece Angela Deidre Ward and my great nephew Anthony Richard David Ward both of 144, Morecambe Road Lancaster Lancs. in equal shares upon their attaining the age of 21 years or if either shall not attain such age to the survivor of them. I direct that any duties payable on

such shares by reason of my death shall be borne by and paid from such shares or the dividends thereof and not from any other portion of my estate.

5. I DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the residue of my property real and personal whatsoever and wheresoever including moneys in the Post Office Savings Bank or any other Bank, National Savings Certificate, cash and personal chattels to my said daughter June Marguerite Boddington.

6. I DESIRE that my body shall be cremated at the Enfield Crematorium and my name added to the memorial of my late husband's tree.

and that the net value of the estate amounts to £ 9560 — 1 — 9

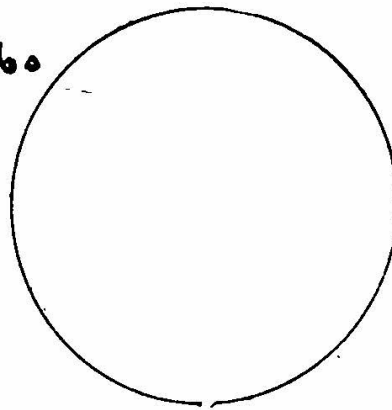
