The petition of Kate Cresswell Pateman hereby filed, respectfully sheweth:

I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to George V, by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions beyond the seas, King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India, of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.

Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 28th day of April, anno Domini 1906, and in the State of OREGON, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the _____ day of JULY, anno Domini 1909, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth.
