disposed of (including the business of a Blacksmith now carried on by me at 27 Perry
Street aforesaid) Unto my Trustees Upon trust that my Trustees shall sell the said
real estate (including chattels real) and call in sell and convert into money such
part of my personal estate as does not consist of money with power to postpone such
sale and conversion for such a period as my Trustees without being liable to account
may think proper and shall out of the moneys to arise from the sale and conversion
of my said real and personal estate and out of my ready money pay my funeral and
testamentary

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testamentary expenses death duties and debts and shall stand possessed of the residue
of the said moneys Upon trust for and to pay and divide the same unto and equally
and
between my two sons the said Henry George Levings and Noel Levings, my daughter Maud
Beatrice Collins With respect to my said business of a Blacksmith my Trustees may
continue the same for such period after my death as they may think fit or discontinue
the same at any time and wind up the affairs thereof with power for my Trustees
if and so long as they shall continue the said business to employ therein the whole
or any part of the capital which shall be employed therein at my death and with power
also to employ managers and assistants in or about the said business and to pay them
such salaries and wages as my Trustees shall think fit and my Trustees shall have
the fullest powers and discretions as to the mode of conducting the said business or
otherwise in relation thereto as if they were the absolute owners thereof and with-
out being answerable for any loss arising thereby During the continuance of the said
business by my Trustees the net profits arising therefrom shall be applied in like
manner as the proceeds of sale of such business if sold would be applicable Subject
to the powers hereinbefore given to them it shall be competent for my Trustees (if
my son the said Noel Levings shall within three calendar months after my death by
notice in writing to be given to my Trustees or either of them offer to purchase my
said business and provided it be not then already sold) to sell my said business to
my son the said Noel Levings at such price including the value of the goodwill as my
Trustees in their absolute discretion shall think fair and reasonable and I direct
that my Trustees may on the sale of my said business to my son the said Noel Levings
allow such proportion of the purchase money as they may think fit to remain a debt
from him to my estate for any period or periods not exceeding three years from the
time of completion of the purchase the principal to be repayable by instalments or
in such other manner as my Trustees may think fit and shall be secured in the mean-
while with interest at the rate of Five pounds per centum per annum in such manner
as my Trustees may think fit I revoke all former Wills by me made IN WITNESS whereof
