Aug 7. Dromal but in fair health. wound healed. Aug 14. No change. Sept 10. No change.

Oct 5. Very dromal, talks reluctantly & never speaks unless spoken to. Does not occupy herself in any useful way. She is forgetful & her memory defective. No regularity of arms. Fair health.

Nov 18. Still dromal but now does a little sewing & reading. Her memory is very defective for recent events better for remote. - she does not know the day or month. can tell her address. 70 Station R. Forest Gate.

Dec 20. No change. Jan 10. No change. Feb 10. Depressed & unsettled. Fair health.

1901 March 16. Complimented.

Aug 6. Removed to West Ham Bos' Asylum. Unimproved.
