SIX MONTHS' IMPRISONMENT FOR WIFE BEATING.—On Friday, Daniel Miles, labourer, of Whitchurch, was apprehended by P.C. Baker under a warrant, charged with assaulting and using violent and threatening language towards his wife, Mary Miles. He was brought before H. E.
